## The Dutch EPR legislation

- Started in July 2023 | First reporting deadline:
  August 2024
- Targets to be met in 2025:
  - 50% reuse and recycling, of which;
    - at least 20% reuse
    - At least 10% reuse in the Netherlands
    - At least 25% of the recycling needs to be fibre-to-fibre
- **Compliance** → **Currently 3 PROs in the Netherlands** 
  - Producers legally individually responsible
  - PRO can fulfill compliance in a collective manner
  - PRO can set fee structure

- Targets to be met in 2030:
  - 75% reuse and recycling, of which;
    - at least 25% reuse
    - At least 15% reuse in the Netherlands
    - At least 33% of the recycling needs to be fibre-to-fibre



## What makes CCT different?

- Started from environmental NGO Fair Resource Foundation
- Based on years of EPR research
